# RS200 Open meeting to be held on

#### 17th October 2020

### **Sailing Instructions**

#### 1. Schedule

- There will be four races sailed back-to-back as conditions permit
- The first warning signal will not be before 12 midday

# 2. Class Flag

• The class flag will be a yellow flag with a black RS200

#### 3. The Start

• The start will be between a yellow pillar buoy and the mast of the committee boat

# 4. Starting sequence

- An orange flag will be flown from the committee with a sound signal five minutes before the Warning Signal of the first race.
- Races will be started in accordance with RRS 26, as follows:
- Five minutes before the Starting signal there will be a Warning signal the class flag will be displayed and a sound signal will be made.
- Four minutes before the start there will be a Preparatory signal either flag P, flag U or a black flag will be displayed (at the race officer's discretion) and a sound signal will be made.
- One minute before the start the preparatory flag will be removed and a long sound signal will be made.
- At the start, the class flag will be removed with a sound signal
- Recalls will be in accordance with RRS 29, as follows:
  - If there is an individual recall, flag X will be displayed with one additional sound signal
  - If there is a general recall, the First Substitute will be displayed with two additional sound signals

# 5. Shortening course

- The course may be shortened in one of two ways:
  - a) in accordance with RRS 32.2 (a) at a rounding mark between the mark and a staff displaying Flag S
  - b) if the committee boat displays Flag S and makes two sound signals, after boats have rounded mark 1 the first time, they must then leave mark 4p to port and cross the finish line.

# 6. Time limits and target times


- Mark 1 time limit for first boat = 30 minutes
- Target race duration for first boat = 40 minutes
- Race time limit for all boats= 60 minutes


# 7. Scoring

• Single discard only if four races are completed

#### 8. Courses and marks

- See attachment A
- The course for each race will be a follows: Start – Mark 1 (port) – Mark 4s (stbd) or Mark 4p (port) – Mark 1 (port) – Mark 4p (port) – Finish





Marks 1, 4p and 4s are large yellow conical marks
